ORDINANCE 1901

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 66, LOAD AND WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ANKENY, IOWA, BY AMENDING SECTION 66.04, LOAD LIMITS ON BRIDGES, TO ALLOW FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A WEIGHT RESTRICTION ON THE FOLLOWING BRIDGE:

1. NE 54TH STREET BRIDGE OVER THE EAST TRIBUTARY TO FOURMILE CREEK, BETWEEN NE HILLCREST DRIVE AND NE BRIARWOOD DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, deems it in the best interest of the City to amend Chapter 66, Load and Weight Restrictions:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 66.04, LOAD LIMITS ON BRIDGES, of the Municipal Code of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, should be and is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

66.04 LOAD LIMITS ON BRIDGES. Where it has been determined that any City bridge has a capacity less than the maximum permitted on the streets of the City, or on the street serving the bridge, the Public Works Director and/or the Police Chief may cause to be posted and maintained signs on said bridge and at suitable distances ahead of the entrances thereof to warn drivers of such maximum load limits, and no person shall drive, pull, or otherwise propel any vehicle weighing, loaded or unloaded, upon said bridge in excess of such posted limit.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.471)

- A. There is fixed for users of the following bridges the maximum load limit, including the weight of the vehicle, together with trailer or other attachments thereto, designated for each bridge:
 - 1. NE 54th Street, over the east tributary to Fourmile Creek, between NE Hillcrest Drive and NE Briarwood Drive, a maximum load limit of 20 tons for straight truck, 34 tons for truck plus semi-trailer, and 36 tons for truck plus trailer. Maximum load limit of 36 tons for all vehicles.

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
