## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FEDERAL-AID AGREEMENT FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDING BETWEEN THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT) AND THE CITY OF ANKENY, IOWA FOR THE SHARING OF PROJECT COSTS FOR THE PROPOSED NE DELAWARE AVENUE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND SIDEWALK CONNECTION PROJECT

**WHEREAS,** in 2014, City of Ankeny staff applied to the Des Moines Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding to facilitate the construction of the NE Delaware Avenue Pedestrian Bridge and Sidewalk Connection project from NE 18<sup>th</sup> Street to approximately 150-ft north of NE 24<sup>th</sup> Court. The MPO subsequently approved the City's application in the amount of 80% of eligible construction costs up to a maximum amount of \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City deems it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City to enter into a federal-aid agreement with the Iowa Department of Transportation for the sharing of project costs for said NE Delaware Avenue Pedestrian Bridge and Sidewalk Connection project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, that the Mayor and City Clerk should be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the said agreement with the Iowa Department of Transportation for Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding.
