Subject: Deer Creek Sidewalk Petition

We, the residents of the city of Ankeny in the subdivision of Deer Creek, petition the City of Ankeny to move up the date to install a sidewalk at the front of the property at 9855 NE Frisk Dr., during the 2017-2021 Five-Year CIP, preferably in 2018. The length of the sidewalk is approximately 200 meters, so the cost and time to complete the project is small compared to other projects in the city, but the impact installing the sidewalk would make on the neighborhood is large. The land sold in 2007, and while the portion of the subdivision along Frisk was not developed with sidewalks until 2013, it's 2017, and the sidewalk is left incomplete. Originally, Public Works planned to finish the sidewalk in 2017 or 2018; however, during the October 2016 CIP planning process, the City of Ankeny moved back the project to 2022.

The signatures were collected from August 26 through September 11, 2017. The signatures on the petitions have been checked against the Polk County Assessor site to ensure only subdivision residents have signed, and we have collected 219 out of 314 household signatures, 289 signatures in total.

Deer Creek is located on the east side of Interstate 35, which isolates it from city parks and adjoining sidewalk systems. Many of the residents actively walk, run, stroll, and cycle the neighborhood. Deer Creek is growing still, and the city and developers have planned for future connection to the city with widened sidewalks along NE 18th St. and sidewalks that tie-in nearly completely around the neighborhood. The other areas have clean lines of sight and relatively flat areas. The property at 9855 NE Frisk Dr. does not, and walking along that stretch is not safe.

Out of respect for the owner's property and due to the difficulty navigating the terrain where the sidewalk should be, most people walk on Frisk Dr. The house rests at the top of a hill and a curve, making it difficult to see traffic and making walking on the street dangerous, yet some residents take the risk. Both sides of Frisk have steep waterways/embankments, and when traffic approaches, residents either switch to the other side of the road or walk on the steep embankment. Switching sides of the road is not possible when both lanes are busy, and traffic from both construction sites and an increased population in the subdivision mean that traffic has increased steadily each year. Residents who walk with children in strollers or on bicycles and residents who have mobility impairments (the neighborhood has at least three wheelchair-bound residents) avoid this area of the neighborhood. It's inaccessible to them.

While other areas of Ankeny are developing as quickly as Deer Creek at this stage, they are also connected to Ankeny's sidewalk and park system. Deer Creek is not, and it will not have a park until 2018, leaving residents with a partial sidewalk network or to travel into town to use safe sidewalks and access to the parks. The subdivision is doubling the land area with Plat 14 and the eastern extension along NE 102nd Ave. to NE 38th St., which means vehicle and foot traffic will increase. The city showed true care for the safety of residents when the sidewalks along NE Four Mile Dr. and NE 102 Ave. were guaranteed, and the residents have been using the sidewalks extensively. Seeing that the original subdivision parcels sold in 2007 and a portion of the



sidewalks along Frisk were completed in 2013, it's time to finish the remaining proposed sidewalk in fiscal year 2018. To finish this sidewalk would mean that all areas of the current subdivision are accessible.

When the city originally approached the property owner a few years ago to build the sidewalk, the city proposed the trees near the sidewalk be removed, and the homeowner and his neighbors share concerns about this. Deer Creek residents support the property owner in those concerns, requesting the city place the sidewalk in a way that would not harm the trees. The sidewalk near the pond along Frisk was diverted, and we believe the city can find a better solution than removing decades-old trees to add a sidewalk.

For the safety of its residents, we make this petition to the city to move up the sidewalk installation date to 2018. The stretch of land the sidewalk covers is small compared to the city's other projects, yet its completion would make a large impact in the safety of its residents.



# Deer Creek Subdivision Sidewalk Petition

We, the residents of the City of Ankeny in the subdivision of Deer Creek, petition the City of Ankeny to move up the installation of the proposed sidewalk located at 9855 NE Frisk Dr., from the current 2017-2021 Five-Year CIP to the 2018 fiscal year. The length of the sidewalk is approximately 200 meters, making the cost and time to complete the project minimal compared to other projects in the city but making a large impact on the safety and quality of life for its residents.

Deer Creek is isolated from city parks and adjoining sidewalk systems. Many of the residents actively walk, run, and cycle the neighborhood during the week and on weekends. Difficulty navigating the terrain where the proposed sidewalk should be results in most people walking on NE Frisk Dr., which is not practical or safe for families with young children or people with disabilities. As the residence is located at the top of a hill along a curve on NE Frisk Dr., pedestrians do not have a clean line of sight to anticipate oncoming traffic when walking on the road, making walking on the street dangerous. As the eastern side of Deer Creek is built (along NE 102nd Ave. to NE 38th St.), the subdivision will double in land area, increasing both residential and construction traffic along with pedestrian traffic. The city showed true care for the safety of residents when the sidewalks along NE Four Mile Dr. and NE 102 Ave. were guaranteed, and the residents have been using the sidewalks extensively. Seeing that the original subdivision parcels sold in 2007 and a portion of the sidewalks along Frisk were completed in 2013, it's time to finish the remaining proposed sidewalk in fiscal year 2018.

For the safety of its residents, we petition to the city to move up the sidewalk installation date to the current 2017-2021 CIP, preferably completing it in 2018.

## Deer Creek Subdivision Sidewalk Petition

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Deer Creek is isolated from city parks and adjoining sidewalk systems. Many of the residents actively walk, run, and cycle the neighborhood during the week and on weekends. Difficulty navigating the terrain where the proposed sidewalk should be results in most people walking on NE Frisk Dr., which is not practical or safe for families with young children or people with disabilities. As the residence is located at the top of a hill along a curve on NE Frisk Dr., pedestrians do not have a clean line of sight to anticipate oncoming traffic when walking on the road, making walking on the street dangerous. As the eastern side of Deer Creek is built (along NE 102nd Ave. to NE 38th St.), the subdivision will double in land area, increasing both residential and construction traffic along with pedestrian traffic. The city showed true care for the safety of residents when the sidewalks along NE Four Mile Dr. and NE 102 Ave. were guaranteed, and the residents have been using the sidewalks extensively. Seeing that the original subdivision parcels sold in 2007 and a portion of the sidewalks along Frisk were completed in 2013, it's time to finish the remaining proposed sidewalk in fiscal year 2018.

For the safety of its residents, we petition to the city to move up the sidewalk installation date to the current 2017-2021 CIP, preferably completing it in 2018.
