

Ankeny Fire Department FY2021 Ambulance Purchase Executive Summary

The Ankeny Fire Department is preparing to purchase a 2020, Type I Ambulance that was approved in the FY2021 Budget process. The specifications for this ambulance are the same as our last unit and have been approved by our Ambulance Specification Team comprised of department personnel (officers, engineers and firefighter EMT's and Paramedics) and a representative of the Central Garage staff. As with our previous purchase, the specifications were developed with the following goals:

- Improve occupant safety
- o Comparable design with existing ambulances
- o Assure the ability for future remount of the ambulance module on a new chassis
- Meet or exceed Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS), KKK-A-1822F and Ambulance Manufacturer Division Standards (AMD)
- Work toward compliance with NFPA 1917 Standard for Automotive Ambulances

Our current H-GAC vendor for Braun Ambulance is North Central Emergency Vehicles. They have informed the department they will be able to provide and ambulance utilizing our last specifications under the H-GAC Buying Group

Recommendation

We propose purchasing this ambulance within the authorized budget amount. We recommend placing the order now as the build time for the ambulance is approximately 255 days which means we would accept delivery well into the next fiscal year.
