

## ORDINANCE 1932

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ANKENY, IOWA, CHAPTER 130 LIQUOR LICENSES AND WINE AND BEER PERMITS

**WHEREAS**, the Ankeny Code of Ordinances regulates liquor licenses and wine and beer permits; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 130.06 sets time limits for those persons under age 21 upon licensed premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, now deems it necessary and proper to amend Chapter 130.06 of the Code of Ordinances to specifically exclude any person under age 21 from remaining upon licensed premises after 11 p.m.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANKENY, IOWA:**

**Section 1:** That Chapter 130.06(12) be and is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and by adding the underlined language:

12. Permit or allow any person under twenty-one (21) years of age to remain upon ~~licensed~~ premises licensed for consumption by the drink unless over fifty percent (50%) of the dollar volume of the business establishment comes from the sale and serving of prepared foods. ~~This provision does not apply to holders of a class "C" beer permit only.~~

**Section 2:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
