## RESOLUTION FIXING DATE FOR A MEETING ON THE PROPOSITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$6,190,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF ANKENY, STATE OF IOWA (FOR ESSENTIAL CORPORATE PURPOSES), AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE THEREOF

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 62-89, adopted April 17, 1989, this Council found and determined that certain areas located within the City are eligible and should be designated as an urban renewal area under Iowa law, and approved and adopted the Ankeny Economic Development Urban Renewal Plan (the "Plan") for the Ankeny Economic Development Urban Renewal Plan Area (the "Area" or "Urban Renewal Area"), which Plan is on file in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2018-148, adopted March 19, 2018, this Council approved and adopted an Amendment No. 8 to the Plan, which Amendment added urban renewal projects proposed to be undertaken within the Area, deleted land, and adopted a finding that the Area contained conditions of blight and proposed blight remediation activities and projects; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and advisable that the City of Ankeny, State of Iowa, should issue General Obligation Bonds, to the amount of not to exceed \$6,190,000, as authorized by Sections 384.25 and 403.12, of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of providing funds to pay costs of carrying out essential corporate purpose projects as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, before bonds may be issued, it is necessary to comply with the procedural requirements of Chapters 384 and 403 of the Code of Iowa, and to publish a notice of the proposal to issue such bonds and the right to petition for an election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF ANKENY, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That this Council meet in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 410 West First Street, Ankeny, Iowa, at <u>5:30</u> P.M., on the 18th day of February, 2019, for the purpose of taking action on the matter of the issuance of not to exceed \$6,190,000 General Obligation Bonds, for essential corporate purposes, the proceeds of which bonds will be used to provide funds to pay the costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of chapter 403, including, but not limited to, SW Des Moines Street – SW Prairie Trail Parkway to SW Magazine Road improvements; SE Creekview Drive drainage and paving improvements; and SE Hulsizer Road Realignment.

Section 2. To the extent any of the projects or activities described in this resolution may be reasonably construed to be included in more than one classification under Division III of Chapter 384 of the Code of Iowa, the Council hereby elects the "essential corporate purpose" classification and procedure with respect to each such project or activity, pursuant to Section 384.28 of the Code of Iowa.

Section 3. That the Clerk is hereby directed to cause at least one publication to be made of a notice of the meeting, in a legal newspaper, printed wholly in the English language, published at least once weekly, and having general circulation in the City. The publication to be not less than ten clear days nor more than twenty days before the date of the public meeting on the issuance of the Bonds.

Section 4. The notice of the proposed action to issue bonds shall be in substantially the following form:
