

ORDINANCE 2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANKENY, IOWA, 2008, BY AMENDING PROVISION PERTAINING TO DOG AND CAT LICENSING REQUIRED

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Ankeny, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 56.01 and 56.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ankeny, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

56.01 LICENSE REQUIRED. Any person owning or harboring a dog or cat of either sex over six months of age shall procure a license therefor from the City Clerk between January 1 and March 31 of each year, or within thirty days of the date any dog or cat is acquired or brought into the City. License renewals after March 31 may be assessed a late fee.

56.02 LICENSE FEE. The annual license fee, penalty, late fee, or any other additional charges or fees for each dog or cat subject to licensing under the provisions of this chapter shall be determined in accordance with an established fee schedule, which fee schedule may be modified from time to time with approval of the council.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect July 1, 2020 and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
