Subject: SummerFest 2024

Background

In 2007, the Ankeny City Council adopted Resolution No. 2007-201 formally recognizing Ankeny SummerFest as a special community festival eligible for support from the City of Ankeny through in-kind services.

In 2011, the Ankeny City Council approved a SummerFest Policy, which established that the City would continue to provide an annual subsidy, within its fiscal capacity, as long as the Ankeny Area Chamber of Commerce managed the event. The policy capped the City's maximum contribution for in-kind services at \$50,000 per year, funded by the hotel/motel tax fund. Although this contribution has traditionally increased 5% each year, it was reduced to \$48,000 in FY 2025 based on actual SummerFest 2023 expenses of \$38,988.49.

Financial and Operational Impacts

The table below represents the history of the City's SummerFest and Celebrate Ankeny commitment of in-kind services (primarily personnel costs and equipment usage):

The FY 2025 budget allocated \$48,000 from the hotel/motel tax fund for SummerFest 2024. However, actual departmental expenses totaled \$49,470.40, resulting in a \$1,470.40 overage. This additional cost was primarily due to the need for additional police hours to support the extended event schedule and maintain a strong police presence, including overwatch positions, bike patrol, and traffic unit, all essential for ensuring a safe event. It is anticipated that the FY 2026 budget allocation to SummerFest 2025 will be increased to better align with the actual costs of the event.

Conclusion

This report is intended to inform elected officials of the City's obligation of resources, operational impacts and costs associated with SummerFest 2024. It also demonstrates the City's commitment to SummerFest and provides valuable information to the Ankeny Area Chamber of Commerce.
