## MINUTES OF THE ANKENY CITY COUNCIL

Mayor Mark Holm called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Council Members Jeff Perry, Joe Ruddy, Todd Shafer, and Kelly Stearns were in attendance. Council Member Bobbi Bentz was absent. City Manager David Jones and City Attorney Amy Beattie were also present. Mayor Holm led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

### PUBLIC FORUM

### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

1. Council Member Shafer moved, Stearns seconded, to approve and accept the December 19, 2022 agenda as presented. Ayes: 4.

## **PUBLIC HEARING**

1. PH 2022-72. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of the proposed Ordinance 2127 vacating a portion of a public storm sewer easement located on Lot 1, John Deere Place Plat 4. Notice of this hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022.

Eric Jensen, Director of Community Development, reported William Doyle, the property owner, has requested the vacation of a portion of a Public Storm Sewer Easement located on Lot 1, John Deere Place Plat 4 to facilitate future development of the site. A subsequent storm sewer easement is proposed in a different location on the property to replace the vacated easement.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Hearing no comments, Council Member Ruddy moved, Shafer seconded, to close public hearing 2022-72. Ayes: 4.

2. PH 2022-73. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of the proposed Ordinance 2128 vacating a portion of a public ingress/egress easement located on Lot 1, John Deere Place Plat 4. Notice of this hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022.

Eric Jensen, Director of Community Development, reported William Doyle, the property owner, has requested the vacation of a portion of a Public Ingress/Egress Easement located on Lot 1, John Deere Place Plat 4 to facilitate future development of the site. All public purpose served by said easement is no longer necessary.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Hearing no comments, Council Member Ruddy moved, Shafer seconded, to close public hearing 2022-73. Ayes: 4.

3. PH 2022-74. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of annexation of certain territory owned by DRA Properties, LC. Layman's Description: Approximately 62.43 acres (+/-) of land in the northeast quadrant generally located east of I-35, north of NE 102nd Avenue (NE 18th Street) and west of NE 29th Street (NE Four Mile Drive) and approximately 12.38 acres (+/-) acres of land adjacent to petitioning parcels. Notices were mailed to affected property owners as required by law and notice of this hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022.

Correspondence dated December 13, 2022, which included a petition from residents in the proposed annexation area was entered into record. Eric Jensen, Director of Community Development, reported the owners of 4 parcels are requesting 62.43 (+/-) acres of land be voluntarily annexed into the City of Ankeny. The land currently petitioned for annexation is 77.75 acres. There are 8 non-consenting parcels that make up the remaining 12.38 acres of the annexation and 2.94 acres of public road right-of-way. The proposed annexation is located in the northeast portion of the City and generally located north of NE 102nd Avenue (NE 18th Street) and west of NE 29th Street (NE Four Mile Drive).

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Voicing concerns and opposition regarding the voluntary urbanized annexation of property requested by DRA Properties, LC were: Jesse Baldwin, 2680 NE 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Ankeny; Martin Vogel, 2298 NW 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Ankeny; Scott Campbell, 2480 NE 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Ankeny; Wallace Shea, 2662 NE 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Ankeny; and Lana Shae, 2662 NE 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Ankeny. Adam Schoeppner, Nilles Associates, Inc., representing DRA Properties LC, spoke about project plans. Council Member Perry moved, Shafer seconded, to close public hearing 2022-74. Ayes: 4.

4. PH 2022-75. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of the proposed 2023-2027 Capital Improvement Program. A notice of hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on December 9, 2022.

Mike Schrock, Assistant City Manager, reported that for 2023-2027, the capital improvement program totals \$200,022,000. Of this total, 57% is identified for transportation projects, 33% for municipal utilities projects, 5% for park facilities, 4% for municipal buildings and 1% for sidewalks/trails.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Hearing no comments, Council Member Stearns moved, Ruddy seconded, to close public hearing 2022-75. Ayes: 4.

5. PH 2022-76. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of the adoption of plans, specifications, form of contract, estimate of cost and enhancement of payment for construction of certain public improvements described in general as construction of the NW 18th Street Reconstruction – NW Ash Drive to North Ankeny Boulevard project. Notice of this hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2022.

Mark Mueller, Public Works Director, reported the NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street Reconstruction – NW Ash Drive to North Ankeny Boulevard project includes reconstructing NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street from a 2-lane urban roadway to a 2-lane urban roadway with a median and designated left and right turn lanes from approximately 400 feet west of NW Ash Drive to North Ankeny Boulevard. The project also includes reconstructing NW Ash Drive with designated left and right turn lanes

from approximately 200 feet south of NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street to approximately 300 feet north of NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Hearing no comments, Council Member Shafer moved, Stearns seconded, to close public hearing 2022-76. Ayes: 4.

6. PH 2022-77. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of the adoption of plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for construction of certain public improvements described in general as construction of the NE Crestmoor Sanitary Sewer Replacement project. Notice of this hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2022.

Don Clark, Municipal Utilities Director, reported The NE Crestmoor Sanitary Sewer Replacement project includes the replacement of sanitary sewer between NE 7th Street and NE 9th Street, in Ankeny, Iowa.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed project. Hearing no comments, Council Member Stearns moved, Ruddy seconded, to close public hearing 2022-77. Ayes: 4.
