

MINUTES OF THE ANKENY CITY COUNCIL

Mayor Mark Holm called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Council Members Bobbi Bentz, Jeff Perry, and Todd Shafer were in attendance. Council Members Joe Ruddy and Kelly Stearns joined the meeting electronically. City Manager David Jones and City Attorney Amy Beattie were also present. Mayor Holm led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC FORUM

1. David Carney, 2613 NW 30th Lane, spoke about city code of ordinances for subdivision regulations and street design standards.
2. Asa Hutton, 827 NE 5th St, Ankeny, addressed Council about increased traffic in his neighborhood due to construction.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

1. Council Member Shafer moved, Perry seconded, to approve and accept the July 15, 2024 agenda without amendment. Ayes: 5.

PUBLIC HEARING

1. PH 2024-43. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of granting a permanent electric easement to the MidAmerican Energy Company to provide electric service for the Rally Complex in Ankeny, Iowa. The notice of hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on the 28th day of June, 2024.

Nick Lenox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported that current construction of the Rally Complex Development Project includes the need for electrical service to provide power for site amenities. MidAmerican Energy will supply the necessary service line to the facility but will need to obtain a Permanent Electric Easement from the City to establish the electric service throughout the site. Since the land is owned by the City of Ankeny and this easement area will be given to MidAmerican Energy, a public hearing is required to allow residents to bring their questions or concerns to our attention. The notice of hearing was published in the Des Moines Register on June 28, 2024.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed easement. Hearing no comments, Council Member Bentz moved, Perry seconded, to close public hearing 2024-43. Ayes: 5.

2. PH 2024-44. Mayor Holm announced this is the time and place for a public hearing on the matter of approving a second amendment to interim tower lease agreement by and between the City of Ankeny and T-Mobile Central, LLC. The notice of hearing on this item was published in the Des Moines Register on the 5th day of July, 2024.

Mike Schrock, Assistant City Manager, reported that T-Mobile is requesting permission to install a new backup generator at the 202 NW Ash Drive property (Ash Water Tower) to service the existing telecom infrastructure on site. T-Mobile has also offered to screen the new generator with a privacy fence that will match the existing fence. Due to the proposed improvements, an amendment to the existing agreement with T-Mobile is necessary. A public

hearing on this amendment to the lease agreement between the parties is required under Section 364.7 of the Iowa Code.

Mayor Holm then asked for any public comment regarding the proposed amendment. Hearing no comments, Council Member Shafer moved, Bentz seconded, to close public hearing 2024-44. Ayes: 5.
